

GUIDELINES FOR SOUND TECH

THE SOUND TECHNICIAN SERVES IN THE BALCONY AND ENSURES APPROPRIATE AMPLIFICATION OF VOICES SO ALL WORSHIPPERS CAN PARTICIPATE FULLY.

Before Worship (arrive by 9:15am):

- ◆ Ensure the sound system is turned on.
- ◆ Check in with whoever is running the livestream to ensure the sound is correctly linked for the day.
- ◆ Check in with Pastor to see if any handheld microphones are needed for the day or if there are any special amplification needs.

During Worship:

- ◆ Be mindful of the volume of the microphones, adjusting as needed. This is especially true for the worship assistant as the microphone is passed to a different volunteer each week who may have a different amplification need.
- ◆ If a volunteer forgets to turn off their microphone and they will not need it for some time, adjust the volume down and then back up for them.

After Worship:

- ◆ Ensure the sound system is turned off, all handheld microphones are returned to the cabinet, and the sound system area is cleaned up for whoever uses it next!

Special Notes:

- ◆ Grace Alive requires additional attention. If you are willing to learn the sound system for these worship services, please speak to Pastor Chelsea, Dan Groth or Gareth Chilcoat.
